Teamwork Equals Production & Safety

At the Jasper Stone plant, we run a small crew of five employees. To meet our tight production schedule, it is important that everyone works together and watches out for each other's safety to meet our deadlines. This involves teamwork.

At Jasper Stone that is exactly what we have. A great team of employees with good communication skills, collaboration, accountability, respect, trust, commitment, and goals. All things needed for a great team.

Here are some projects we are currently working on in Sioux Falls.

National Guard Readiness Center

This project consists of 1 ½" flamed panels cut to various dimensions for precast walls. There are 510 pieces of wall panels, ranging from 18" x 36" down to 3" x 2".

We need to drill 3,144, ¼" x 1" deep anchor holes. Total sq/ft of exposed area will be 1,423.

We are working with Collins Pre-Cast from Iroquois, SD, we hope to partner with them on future projects.

It's Grill Season

According to the **National Fire Protection Association**, an average of 10,600 fires are started by grills each year. Whether you own a gas grill, charcoal grill, or smoker, putting safety first before you fire up to cook is imperative.



- Keep the grill at least 10 feet from your home.

- Grill on a level surface.
- Keep a fire extinguisher near the grill.
- Wear a heavy apron and oven mitts.
- Use long-handled utensils.
- Clean your grill regularly.
- Put coals and embers in a metal can, away from your home.
