Every day we hear how our country's supply chain disruptions cause delays and inflation, however, we are able to minimize delays through vertical integration. Vertical integration is a strategy in which all of the components of the supply chain are controlled within the company. With L. G. Everist aggregates, D&I Railroad rail transportation, Myrl & Roy's asphalt services and transportation, and Ace Ready Mix concrete services, we own the supply chain from mining to end use.

There are thousands of processes within this internal integration. A crucial step is maintaining D & I Railroad infrastructure. Like any other transportation infrastructure, it does not last forever. Railroad bridge replacement is one of the disruptions in the chain. Two and a half miles southeast of Canton, South Dakota we have replaced a 70-year-old, 142-foot timber trestle bridge. The new 125-foot precast prestressed concrete girder bridge on steel piles will span across Nelson Creek for the *next* 100 years. This original railroad line was constructed just a few short years after L. G. Everist was established, in the 1880's.

With the help of everyone in the supply chain we were able to replace this bridge from start to finish in less than a month with minimal disruption to train traffic. From rock to rail, we can attest to the safe and efficient solutions provided by LGE.
