For nearly 25 years, the Fort Lupton plant in Colorado has been a cornerstone of the state's construction industry, providing high-quality sand and gravel for a diverse range of projects. From contributing to the construction of Denver International Airport's runways to supplying materials for Tournament Players Club golf courses and numerous other sites, the plant has played a pivotal role in shaping the region. Its consistent output and reliability have made it an enduring asset to local construction efforts.

As the plant moves toward the end of its current phase—collecting remaining materials from various pits, finalizing reclamation plans, and cleaning up from modifications past—we face the natural conclusion of this chapter. However, this ending is not as final as it may seem.

As mentioned in a previous Roxsand, we have acquired 430 acres of land to the north, ensuring the plant's extended future. With permitting, planning, and re-planning already underway, we are preparing for an expansion that will sustain the plant's operations for many more years. As we extend our reach, we remain committed to maintaining and nurturing the positive relationships with our neighbors, continuing to assist them whenever and wherever possible.

## **Fort Lupton, CO**

Fort Lupton is home to over 8,600 residents and is located along the South Platte River, about 30 miles northeast of Denver.

The city was first established as a trading post and stage coach station, circa 1838, and currently offers various attractions such as a scenic golf course, vineyard, museum, and outdoor recreational opportunities.

LGE first acquired 80 acres in this area in 1999. The current permitted acreage at our Fort Lupton Sand & Gravel site is over 600 acres and employs a dedicated team of 10 individuals.
